IRREGULAR VERB

To walk, to go, to go around

Past participle	andado (walked)
Gerund	andando (walking)

Indicative Tenses

Yo <i>I</i>	ando <i>I walk</i>	anduve ● <i>I walked</i>	andaba <i>I used to walk</i>	andaré <i>I will walk</i>	andaría <i>I would walk</i>
Tú <i>You</i>	andas <i>you walk</i>	anduviste ● <i>you walked</i>	andabas <i>you used to walk</i>	andarás <i>you will walk</i>	andarías <i>you would walk</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (frm)</i>	anda <i>s/he walk</i>	anduvo ● <i>s/he walked</i>	andaba <i>s/he used to walk</i>	andará <i>s/he will walk</i>	andaría <i>s/he would walk</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	andamos <i>we walk</i>	anduvimos ● <i>we walked</i>	andábamos <i>we used to walk</i>	andaremos <i>we will walk</i>	andaríamos <i>we would walk</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (pl)</i>	andáis <i>you (pl) walk</i>	anduvisteis ● <i>you (pl) walked</i>	andabais <i>you (pl) used to walk</i>	andaréis <i>you (pl) will walk</i>	andaríais <i>you (pl) would walk</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (pl frm)</i>	andan <i>they walk</i>	anduvieron ● <i>they walked</i>	andaban <i>they used to walk</i>	andarán <i>they will walk</i>	andarían <i>they would walk</i>

Pronoun	Present Perfect	Past Perfect	Future Perfect	Conditional Perfect
Yo <i>I</i>	he andado <i>I have walked</i>	había andado <i>I had walked</i>	habré andado <i>I will have walked</i>	habría andado <i>I would have walked</i>
Tú <i>You</i>	has andado <i>you have walked</i>	habías andado <i>you had walked</i>	habrás andado <i>you will have walked</i>	habrías andado <i>you would have walked</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (frm)</i>	ha andado <i>s/he has walked</i>	había andado <i>s/he had walked</i>	habrá andado <i>s/he will have walked</i>	habría andado <i>s/he would have walked</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	hemos andado <i>we have walked</i>	habíamos andado <i>we had walked</i>	habremos andado <i>we will have walked</i>	habríamos andado <i>we would have walked</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (pl)</i>	habéis andado <i>you (pl) have walked</i>	habíais andado <i>you (pl) had walked</i>	habréis andado <i>you (pl) will have walked</i>	habríais andado <i>you (pl) would have walked</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (pl frm)</i>	han andado <i>they have walked</i>	habían andado <i>they had walked</i>	habrán andado <i>they will have walked</i>	habrían andado <i>they would have walked</i>

Subjunctive Tenses

Pronoun	Present	Imperfect	Future
Yo <i>I</i>	ande <i>I walk</i>	anduviera ● <i>I walked</i>	anduviere ● <i>I will walk</i>
Tú <i>You</i>	andes <i>you walk</i>	anduvieras ● <i>you walked</i>	anduvieres ● <i>you will walk</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (frml)</i>	ande <i>s/he walk</i>	anduviera ● <i>s/he walked</i>	anduviere ● <i>s/he will walk</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	andemos <i>we walk</i>	anduviéramos ● <i>we walked</i>	anduviéremos ● <i>we will walk</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (prl)</i>	andéis <i>you (pl) walk</i>	anduvierais ● <i>you (pl) walked</i>	anduviereis ● <i>you (pl) will walk</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (prl frml)</i>	anden <i>they walk</i>	anduvieran ● <i>they walked</i>	anduvieren ● <i>they will walk</i>

Pronoun	Present Perfect	Past Perfect	Future Perfect
Yo <i>I</i>	haya andado <i>I have walked</i>	hubiera andado <i>I had walked</i>	hubiere andado <i>I will have walked</i>
Tú <i>You</i>	hayas andado <i>you have walked</i>	hubieras andado <i>you had walked</i>	hubieres andado <i>you will have walked</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (frml)</i>	haya andado <i>s/he has walked</i>	hubiera andado <i>s/he had walked</i>	hubiere andado <i>s/he will have walked</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	hayamos andado <i>we have walked</i>	hubiéramos andado <i>we had walked</i>	hubiéremos andado <i>we will have walked</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (prl)</i>	hayáis andado <i>you (pl) have walked</i>	hubierais andado <i>you (pl) had walked</i>	hubiereis andado <i>you (pl) will have walked</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (prl frml)</i>	hayan andado <i>they have walked</i>	hubieran andado <i>they had walked</i>	hubieren andado <i>they will have walked</i>

The red dot (●) above denotes an irregular conjugation.

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
