Tú <i>You</i>	has colado <i>you have strained</i>	habías colado <i>you had strained</i>	habrás colado <i>you will have strained</i>	habrías colado <i>you would have strained</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (frm)</i>	ha colado <i>s/he has strained</i>	había colado <i>s/he had strained</i>	habrá colado <i>s/he will have strained</i>	habría colado <i>s/he would have strained</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	hemos colado <i>we have strained</i>	habíamos colado <i>we had strained</i>	habremos colado <i>we will have strained</i>	habríamos colado <i>we would have strained</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (pl)</i>	habéis colado <i>you (pl) have strained</i>	habíais colado <i>you (pl) had strained</i>	habréis colado <i>you (pl) will have strained</i>	habrías colado <i>you (pl) would have strained</i>

Tú <i>You</i>	cueles ● <i>you strain</i>	colaras <i>you strained</i>	colares <i>you will strain</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (frml)</i>	cuele ● <i>s/he strains</i>	colara <i>s/he strained</i>	colare <i>s/he will strain</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	colemos <i>we strain</i>	coláramos <i>we strained</i>	coláremos <i>we will strain</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (prl)</i>	coléis <i>you (pl) strain</i>	colarais <i>you (pl) strained</i>	colareis <i>you (pl) will strain</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (prl frml)</i>	cuelen ● <i>they strain</i>	colaran <i>they strained</i>	colaren <i>they will strain</i>

Pronoun	Present Perfect	Past Perfect	Future Perfect
Yo <i>I</i>	haya colado <i>I have strained</i>	hubiera colado <i>I had strained</i>	hubiere colado <i>I will have strained</i>
Tú <i>You</i>	hayas colado <i>you have strained</i>	hubieras colado <i>you had strained</i>	hubieres colado <i>you will have strained</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (frml)</i>	haya colado <i>s/he has strained</i>	hubiera colado <i>s/he had strained</i>	hubiere colado <i>s/he will have strained</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	hayamos colado <i>we have strained</i>	hubiéramos colado <i>we had strained</i>	hubiéremos colado <i>we will have strained</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (prl)</i>	hayáis colado <i>you (pl) have strained</i>	hubierais colado <i>you (pl) had strained</i>	hubiereis colado <i>you (pl) will have strained</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (prl frml)</i>	hayan colado <i>they have strained</i>	hubieran colado <i>they had strained</i>	hubieren colado <i>they will have strained</i>
