Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (fml)</i>	habitúese ● <i>(to you fml) get! used to</i>	no se habitúe ● <i>(to you fml) don't get! used to</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	habituémonos <i>let's get! used to</i>	no nos habituemos <i>let's not get! used to</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (pl)</i>	habituaos <i>(to you pl) get! used to</i>	no os habituéis <i>(to you pl) don't get! used to</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (pl fml)</i>	habitúense ● <i>(to you pl fml) get! used to</i>	no se habitúen ● <i>(to you pl fml) don't get! used to</i>
