Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (fml)</i>	harte <i>s/he annoys</i>	hartara <i>s/he annoyed</i>	hartare <i>s/he will annoy</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	hartemos <i>we annoy</i>	hartáramos <i>we annoyed</i>	hartáremos <i>we will annoy</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (pl)</i>	hartéis <i>you (pl) annoy</i>	hartarais <i>you (pl) annoyed</i>	hartareis <i>you (pl) will annoy</i>

Pronoun	Affirmative	Negative
Tú <i>You</i>	harta <i>(to you) annoy!</i>	no hartes <i>(to you) don't annoy!</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (fml)</i>	harte <i>(to you fml) annoy!</i>	no harte <i>(to you fml) don't annoy!</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	hartemos <i>let's annoy!</i>	no hartemos <i>let's not annoy!</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (pl)</i>	hartad <i>(to you pl) annoy!</i>	no hartéis <i>(to you pl) don't annoy!</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (pl fml)</i>	harten <i>(to you pl fml) annoy!</i>	no harten <i>(to you pl fml) don't annoy!</i>
