Usted You (fml)	péguese <i>(to you fml) stick to!</i>	no se pegue <i>(to you fml) don't stick to!</i>
Nosotras/os We	peguémonos <i>let's stick to!</i>	no nos peguemos <i>let's not stick to!</i>
Vosotras/os You (pl)	pegaos <i>(to you pl) stick to!</i>	no os peguéis <i>(to you pl) don't stick to!</i>
Ustedes You (pl fml)	peguense <i>(to you pl fml) stick to!</i>	no se peguen <i>(to you pl fml) don't stick to!</i>
