Vosotras/os You (pl)	provenid <i>(to you pl) come from!</i>	no proven ga ís <i>(to you pl) don't come from!</i>
Ustedes You (pl fml)	proven ga n <i>(to you pl fml) come from!</i>	no proven ga n <i>(to you pl fml) don't come from!</i>
