Yo <i>I</i>	he sonado <i>I have sounded</i>	había sonado <i>I had sounded</i>	habré sonado <i>I will have sounded</i>	habría sonado <i>I would have sounded</i>
Tú <i>You</i>	has sonado <i>you have sounded</i>	habías sonado <i>you had sounded</i>	habrás sonado <i>you will have sounded</i>	habrías sonado <i>you would have sounded</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (frm)</i>	ha sonado <i>s/he has sounded</i>	había sonado <i>s/he had sounded</i>	habrá sonado <i>s/he will have sounded</i>	habría sonado <i>s/he would have sounded</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	hemos sonado <i>we have sounded</i>	habíamos sonado <i>we had sounded</i>	habremos sonado <i>we will have sounded</i>	habríamos sonado <i>we would have sounded</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (pl)</i>	habéis sonado <i>you (pl) have sounded</i>	habíais sonado <i>you (pl) had sounded</i>	habréis sonado <i>you (pl) will have sounded</i>	habrías sonado <i>you (pl) would have sounded</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (pl frm)</i>	han sonado <i>they have sounded</i>	habían sonado <i>they had sounded</i>	habrán sonado <i>they will have sounded</i>	habrían sonado <i>they would have sounded</i>

Subjunctive Tenses

Pronoun	Present	Imperfect	Future
Yo <i>I</i>	suene ● <i>I sound</i>	sonara <i>I sounded</i>	sonare <i>I will sound</i>
Tú <i>You</i>	suenes ● <i>you sound</i>	sonaras <i>you sounded</i>	sonares <i>you will sound</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (frml)</i>	suene ● <i>s/he sounds</i>	sonara <i>s/he sounded</i>	sonare <i>s/he will sound</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	sonemos <i>we sound</i>	sonáramos <i>we sounded</i>	sonáremos <i>we will sound</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (prl)</i>	sonéis <i>you (pl) sound</i>	sonarais <i>you (pl) sounded</i>	sonareis <i>you (pl) will sound</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (prl frml)</i>	suenen ● <i>they sound</i>	sonaran <i>they sounded</i>	sonaren <i>they will sound</i>

Pronoun	Present Perfect	Past Perfect	Future Perfect
Yo <i>I</i>	haya sonado <i>I have sounded</i>	hubiera sonado <i>I had sounded</i>	hubiere sonado <i>I will have sounded</i>
Tú <i>You</i>	hayas sonado <i>you have sounded</i>	hubieras sonado <i>you had sounded</i>	hubieres sonado <i>you will have sounded</i>
Ella / Él / Ud <i>She/he/you (frml)</i>	haya sonado <i>s/he has sounded</i>	hubiera sonado <i>s/he had sounded</i>	hubiere sonado <i>s/he will have sounded</i>
Nosotras/os <i>We</i>	hayamos sonado <i>we have sounded</i>	hubiéramos sonado <i>we had sounded</i>	hubiéremos sonado <i>we will have sounded</i>
Vosotras/os <i>You (prl)</i>	hayáis sonado <i>you (pl) have sounded</i>	hubierais sonado <i>you (pl) had sounded</i>	hubiereis sonado <i>you (pl) will have sounded</i>
Ellas/os / Uds <i>They/you (prl frml)</i>	hayan sonado <i>they have sounded</i>	hubieran sonado <i>they had sounded</i>	hubieren sonado <i>they will have sounded</i>
